

The conference, “Willowbrook, Keeping the Promise,” will examine the history and impact of the landmark Willowbrook litigation. The Willowbrook case, instituted forty years ago in the federal district court by the New York Civil Liberties Union on behalf of NYSARC and certain named individuals, challenged the constitutionality of the care and treatment provided to individuals who resided at the Willowbrook State School and established a standard of care that drove significant reforms in New York’s system of delivering services to individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

High ranking state officials, former and current Willowbrook attorneys and advocates, and statewide provider agency executives will be participating in the conference and examining the current challenges of fulfilling the promise of Willowbrook. This conference, hosted by Albany Law School’s Government Law Center and the Civil Rights and Disabilities Law Clinic, is not to be missed.
