

Guide to Eligibility Assessment Resources

The Office for People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD) is pleased to provide you with this diagnostic evaluation resource guide. This guide was developed to help individuals, families, service providers and other interested parties to locate testing and assessment services available in their local communities. In many cases, the agencies listed offer other services in addition to diagnostic assessments.

The information in this guide was collected with the assistance of our Developmental Disabilities Service Offices (DDSOs) staff. This guide is intended as a directory of assessment services. This is not an exclusive list of testing and assessment services nor does inclusion on the list indicate OPWDD approval or endorsement of the provider.

OPWDD expects providers to conduct evaluations and assessments in accordance with national professional standards and with the testing and diagnostic guidelines included in the manuals for the applicable testing instruments. Failure to adhere to such standards requires OPWDD to question the validity of the assessment results. Depending on the complexity of an individual's condition, and the date of any prior evaluations, the process for obtaining an OPWDD services eligibility determination could require multiple or specialty assessments that are done by providers not listed in this Guide. We recommend that you work with the Eligibility Coordinator at your local DDSO to ensure that you have submitted a complete eligibility packet when requesting an eligibility determination.

We hope this guide is a valuable resource that assists you in obtaining the services you need. We strive to maintain the accuracy of the information provided, and intend to update this guide on a regular basis.
