

# Guide to Eligibility Assessment Resources

The Office for People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD) is pleased to provide you with this diagnostic evaluation resource guide. This guide was developed to help individuals, families, service providers and other interested parties to locate testing and assessment services available in their local communities. In many cases, the agencies listed offer other services in addition to diagnostic assessments.

The information in this guide was collected with the assistance of our Developmental Disabilities Regional Offices (DDRO) staff. This guide is intended as a directory of assessment services. This is not an exclusive list of testing and assessment services nor does inclusion on the list indicate OPWDD approval or endorsement of the provider.

OPWDD expects providers to conduct evaluations and assessments in accordance with national professional standards and with the testing and diagnostic guidelines included in the manuals for the applicable testing instruments. Failure to adhere to such standards requires OPWDD to question the validity of the assessment results. We recommend that you work with the Eligibility Coordinator at your local DDRO to ensure that you have submitted a complete eligibility packet when requesting an eligibility determination.
