MSC Training Delivery: Medicaid Service Coordination Monthly Note

Attached to this e-visory is a letter dated, December 4, 2012 announcing the availability of the Medicaid Service Coordination (MSC) Monthly Note training curriculum. The Medicaid Service Coordination Note (MSC 10 or MSC 10b format) is the required contemporaneous note necessary to substantiate billing for MSC. This training is an overview of the fiscal and quality standards related to MSC service note documentation. COMPASS agencies, provider agencies or other organizations that have already obtained approval from OPWDD to deliver MSC Core training may now begin utilizing these materials to deliver Medicaid Service Coordination (MSC) Monthly Note training.
